## Driving on the Highway of God: Merge vs. Yield?



Within the last month, we have received confirmation from the Office of our District Superintendent, Rev. Joe Tyson, that the proposed merger between our church and the Covenant United Methodist Church is now "on hold." The members of the Covenant Church are evaluating their ministry with the hope of continuing to remain as an active congregation in their own church.

Of course, as a Christian family ourselves, we must take this news with the confidence that God always knows what He's doing . . . and this is by no means any kind of "setback" to our desire for church growth.

Your response to the initial news of the proposed merger was very commendable! You all seemed to be very positive and welcoming . . . which are certainly characteristics of people devoted to God and gifted with His grace! However, as we continue to travel on the path that God has already mapped out for us . . . since we will not be "merging". . . we now must "yield." We have seen that triangle-shaped yellow sign that urges "caution" and we are paused on the highway ramp. We must look around . . . evaluate our situation . . . and make sure the way is clear before we proceed further on our journey.

Even though we desire "church growth," we must keep in mind that we are indeed already connecting many people with God's love. Many ministries happen during the course of the year that touch lives with God's love . . . and we may not even be aware of the impact our church is having on our community and the world.

Recently, we have seen many new people with us during Sunday morning worship and this always makes us thankful. Let's continue to carefully examine our consciences and God's will as we are now in this position of "yielding" to God's plans. The first requirement to proceeding appropriately is to continue to pray for direction. Just as we would never move forward into traffic that is risky . . . so also we cannot move forward on God's journey for us without wisdom, peace, and joy!

God will provide opportunities for us to serve, and will most certainly show us how to follow Him as his loving disciples.
