Capital Improvement Project

Our church family at Iona is extremely blessed by God and has been able to successfully finance our church operations, missions, and capital improvements this year. The Finance Committee thanks all of you for your faithfulness and generous giving.

Recently the trustees have been advised that the parking lot is in need of attention. If we don't do something soon, plowing the snow in the winter will become difficult and digging up the entire area may become necessary in the future. For those reasons, the Finance Committee suggested that the trustees obtain bids for the repaving of the entire area, front and side.

At the June meeting, the administrative council approved the awarding of a contract to Hackman Paving. The work is scheduled to begin the first week of September.

There is a balance of approximately \$36,800 in the Capital Improvements fund which will be used for this project. Repaving the entire parking lot will cost about \$45,000. If you would like to contribute to this project, please give through the Capital Improvements line on your envelope. Thank you.
