

Many of you have been asking questions about the transition about to take place at the Avon

United Methodist Church. So, to avoid rumor and speculation, Pastor Beth has been in contact with the District Superintendent who has passed along the following information.

It is true that the Avon United Methodist Church plans to "close" as of June 30, 2018. The members of the church have chosen to each seek a new church on their own rather than be "moved" or "assigned" to another church. Some have existing ties to other Methodist churches and others just want to "shop around." A new Spanish-speaking Methodist Church will move into the building to utilize the much-needed extra space.

Therefore, we have a unique opportunity to contact the people of Avon and invite them to join us in worship, or to go there in order to introduce ourselves. But, in order to "mind our manners," the District Superintendent has suggested that Pastor Beth speak with the Pastor of Avon so he is fully informed of our outreach to his congregation. He may even be able to provide some suggestions as to how and when we could get together.
